Sue Gray also announced she would check out some other places for a retreat and tell the guild in December what she found. The guild would decide if they wanted to move one of the retreats or not.



Thanks to all the ladies that have been taking on the small quilts to do free motion quilting on them, they are looking great and giving you lots of practice.


The count of items donated in November was 160 Receiving Blankets and 20 Quilts.


