Unit 6 (label and put in ziplock bag)

Instructions given for Lap Size. Twin Size will be in parenthesis.

## **Summary:**


Make 72 (144) half square triangles using fabric 2 & 5. Unfinished size should be 2 ½" X 2 ½"

## **Detail Instructions:**

- Fabric 2 Cut 9 (18) 5 ¾ " square (or 6" square if you like to cut down your half sq triangles to 2 ½")
- Fabric 5 Cut 9 (18) 5 ¾ " square (or 6" square if you like to cut down your half sq triangles to 2 ½")
- (1) Mark 2 Diagonal lines on Fabric 5 (see Diagram). Line up Fabric 2 and 5 with right sides together.
- (2) With right sides together (fabric 2 & 5) sew ¼" on both sides of the diagonal marked lines.
- (3) Cut each unit in half both horizonal and vertical (see diagram)
- Cut mark diagonal lines.
- Press Half Square toward Fabric 2.
- Total of 8 Half Square triangles per 5 ¾" squares.


## #1 Mark Diagonal Lines

from Corner to Corner on light fabric



#2 Right sides together (fabric 2 & 5)
Sew ¼" on each side of the Marked lines

5 ¼ " Square



5 ¾ " Square
