## Summary:

Make 9 Sawtooth Star Blocks unfinished size should be $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Cutting Instructions:

Fabric 3-Cut 9-4 1/2" X $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Squares
Fabric $3-$ Cut $36-3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Squares
Fabric 2 - Cut 9-5 $1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Squares
Fabric 2 - Cut 36-2 $1 / 2 \prime$ " $\times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Squares

Making the Quick-Pieced Flying Geese Units: (Do this 9 times to make 36 units)

- On wrong side of each of the Fabric 3-3" squares, draw a diagonal line.
- Place two $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares atop each Fabric 2-5 $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square right sides together and sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from drawn line and cut on drawn line between the sewing lines. Press seams toward small triangles.

- Place 2 marked $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares atop each triangle units and sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from drawn line and cut on drawn lines between the sewing lines. Press seams towards small triangle to complete the flying geese and square up to $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make 36 Flying Geese Units.
