Summary:

Make 9 Sawtooth Star Blocks unfinished size should be $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$

Fabric 3 – Cut 9 – $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ Squares

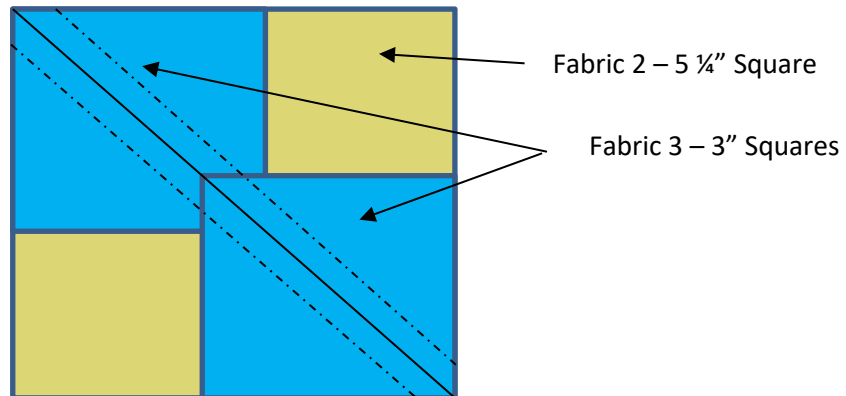
Fabric 3 – Cut 36 – $3'' \times 3''$ Squares

Fabric 2 – Cut 9 – $5\frac{1}{4}'' \times 5\frac{1}{4}''$ Squares

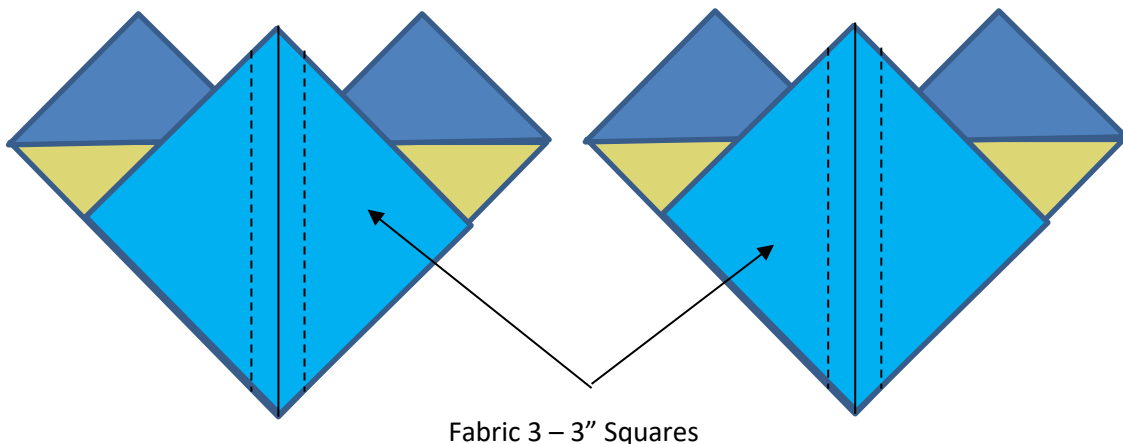
Fabric 2 – Cut 36 – $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ Squares

Making the Quick-Pieced Flying Geese Units: (Do this 9 times to make 36 units)

- On wrong side of each of the Fabric 3 - $3''$ squares, draw a diagonal line.
- Place two $3''$ squares atop each Fabric 2 - $5\frac{1}{4}''$ square right sides together and sew $\frac{1}{4}''$ from drawn line and cut on drawn line between the sewing lines. Press seams toward small triangles.

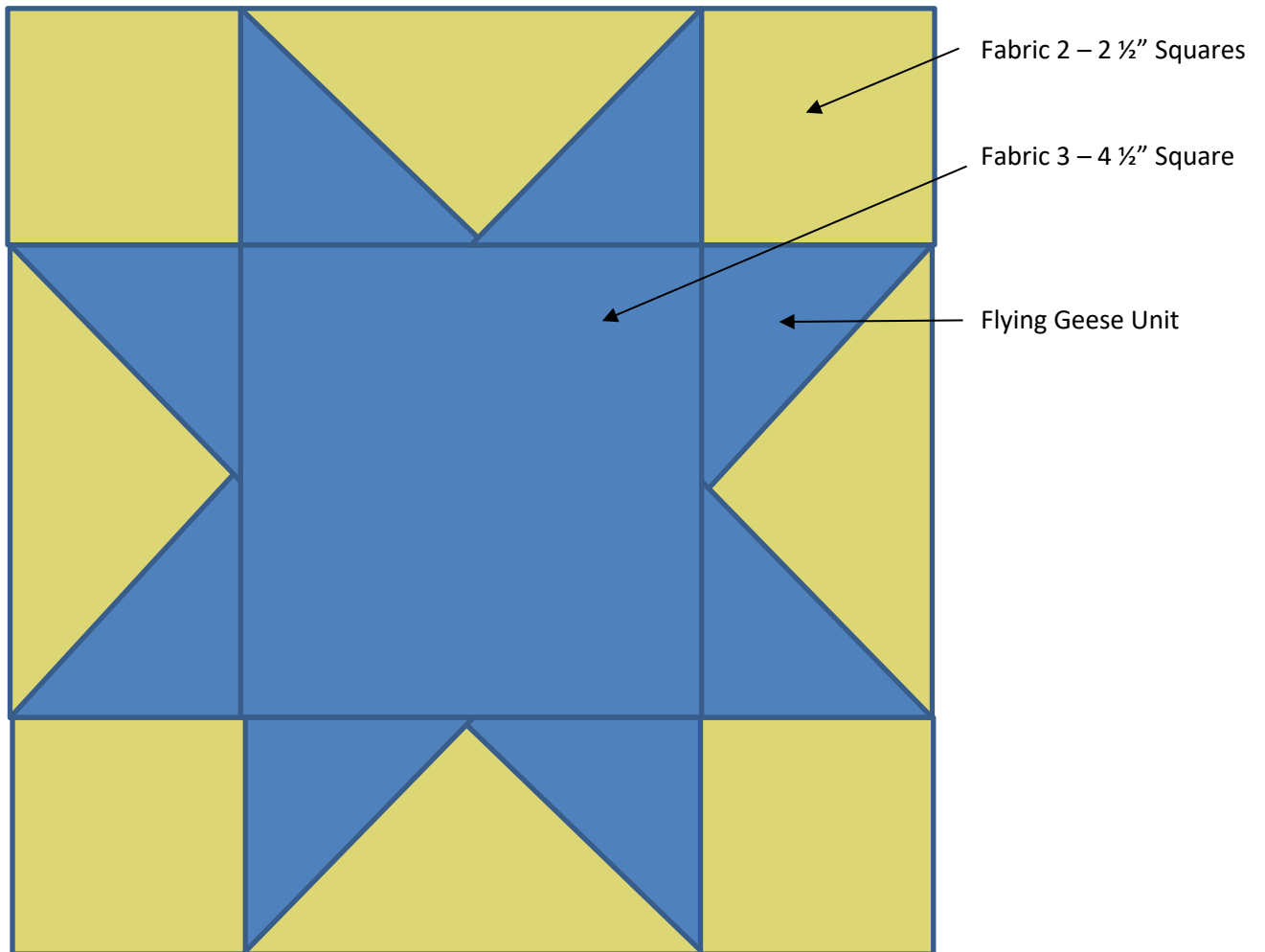


- Place 2 marked $3''$ squares atop each triangle units and sew $\frac{1}{4}''$ from drawn line and cut on drawn lines between the sewing lines. Press seams towards small triangle to complete the flying geese and square up to $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$. Make 36 Flying Geese Units.

Arrange the cut fabric and flying geese according to the diagram and sew units together. Make 9 Blocks.
